- **A Family Day (3rd day)**, a unique opportunity for ED-affected families to interact with specialists and attend Q&A sessions tailored to their needs.

Additionally, the third day offers an opportunity for medical delegates to meet and connect with people affected by ED. Family members will be able to hear firsthand from medical professionals, who will also join a panel for Q&As.

As the only dedicated support hub for those affected by ED in UK, we are determined to welcome as many families as possible to our Family Day. We recognize that financial constraints can be a significant barrier for some families, and we are committed to finding ways to assist those who may need help attending this important event.
